

TCA Community Service



- Community service is defined as any service the student is not paid to do or expected to do as a family member.
- ***Each high school student is required to volunteer a total of eighty (80) hours by April 15th of the senior year.***
- Documentation forms are available on the Guidance page of the TCA website, in the guidance office, or in the main office. These forms are to be completed by the agency or individual for whom the service is being rendered and returned to the guidance office. Community service hours must be completed by April 15th of the senior year.
- Places of services may include but are not limited to:
 - Community Agencies - RIFA, Habitat for Humanity, etc.
 - Church - Vacation Bible School, Mission Work, etc.
 - School – Teacher/ Classroom Aides, Sports/Fine Art Camps, etc.
 - Individuals (non-relative) - Yard Work, Cleaning, etc.
- Generally, hours are granted on an hour-by-hour basis with some established limits. A few examples are:

Mission Trip	6 hours per day
TCA Athletic/Fine Art Support Service	Hour for hour
<i>(Date/hour documentation required or 50 hour max awarded)</i>	
Office/Teacher Student Aide	Hour for hour
TCA Elementary Classroom Assistant	Hour for hour
Vacation Bible School	Hour for hour
