Hours of Operation:

-7:30 am- 5:30pm

-May 28th - July 31st

-Closed Monday, May 27th and Thursday, July 4th & 5th

-Parents are responsible for having their child picked up no later than 5:30 pm. **There will be a \$25.00 late fee for pick-up past 5:30. Have your payment ready at pick-up if you are later than 5:30.**

Snacks/Lunches:

Lunch and snacks will be provided. We will order out. Please let us know of any food allergies.

Field Trips:

We will have several field trips for 1st -5th graders only. Your child will be required to wear his/her field trip t-shirt each time we have a trip scheduled. We will furnish this shirt.

Dress Code:

Campers are allowed to wear t-shirts and modest shorts. Tank tops and sleeveless shirts are fine. No strapless, spaghetti straps, or revealing shirts are allowed. Students are encouraged to wear tennis shoes since they will be playing outside daily and in the gym. On scheduled water days, one piece bathing suits are preferred, but tankinis are okay as long as they are modest. **The camp director holds they right to make changes to the dress code as the need arises.**

Rest Time:

LL- K will have a time of rest in the afternoon. Mats will be provided; however, you will need to provide a mat cover with blanket.

Discipline:

Trinity Christian Academy, like any community or organization, must have a basic set of rules for behavior that promotes self-control, character and an environment where learning can take place. Students are expected to behave in a manner which demonstrates a respect for self, others, and recognition of the responsibilities of being part of a Christian educational community. When a student is involved in a disciplinary incident, parents will be informed. If parents have questions, concerns, or comments concerning the incident, they are encouraged to contact the teacher directly involved in the incident. If parents have additional concerns after contacting the faculty member, they should contact the Director.

Loss of Privileges - There are many privileges for students who attend TCA's summer camp. When a student is issued a loss of privilege, he or she will be unable to utilize some or all of the privileges that are available. These privileges may include, but are not limited to, optional eating areas at lunch, recess time, and sitting out during activities. When this happens, your child will come home with a behavior form for you to sign. This is an important form of communication. If it requires a phone call or further action, you will be notified by the Director. The behavior expected by each child provides a safe and positive environment for all campers.

Check in and out

Parents must come inside to sign their child in and out each day. **Your child will not be allowed to leave with anyone other than his or her parents or those listed on the pick-up list unless we receive notice by email or phone by the parent.** Email tammy.oliphant@mytcalions.com or call 731-410-8227.
