

**Trinity Christian Academy
2020 Football Game Procedures**

This plan outlines best practices in keeping with recommendations from the Centers of Disease Control, the Jackson-Madison Co. Regional Health Department, Governor Lee's Tennessee's Economic Recovery Group Tennessee Pledge: Reopening Tennessee Responsibly and the TSSAA to return in a way that will help keep students, school staff and spectators safe during the COVID-19 pandemic.

- **Facial mask or covering will be required to enter and worn at ALL TIMES while on site.**
- **Social distancing will be required and maintained at ALL TIMES while on site.**
- Temperature check for everyone (including players, coaches, team personnel, administrators, event staff, officials, spectators, etc..) entering the facilities. Anyone with a temperature reading at or above 100.4° or above will not be allowed to enter and must leave the premises. Visiting teams will be responsible for their own temperature checks for coaches, players, and team personnel. Host team will verify.
- Everyone (including players, coaches, team personnel, administrators, event staff, officials, spectators, etc..) will be screened for COVID-19 exposure and/or symptoms before entering the facilities. Anyone answering yes to any of the questions in the screening process will not be allowed to enter and must leave the premise. **Honesty and transparency are needed and expected.** Visiting teams will be responsible for their own screening checks for coaches, players and all team personnel. Host team will verify.
- Seat capacity will be limited and designated due to social distancing guidelines.
- Fans will not be allowed to enter the premises until 45 minutes prior to game time.
- We will attempt to pre-sale as many tickets as possible each week through the digital online app GoFan for \$8.00 per ticket. Visiting teams will be offered pre-sale tickets.
- Only the main entrance to our campus will be open for access to the entry into the stadium. Booster parking will be designated closest to the stadium entrance. Parking passes can be purchased a season parking pass for an additional \$25 per vehicle. Non booster club members can purchase a season parking pass for \$50. Please contact boosterclubtca@gmail.com to reserve your premium spot. All other fans will park in the lots directly in front of the school's main building. All other parking lots on campus behind the gym and stadium as well as the access road to the back entrance will all be closed to fans and traffic to help with crowd control.
- Student sections, bands or drum lines will be assigned a designated area on the track.
- There will be 10' x 10' family sections marked off in the grass area to each side of the home and guest bleachers but chairs will not be provided.
- There will be 10' x 10' sections marked off in the endzone track area but chairs will not be provided.
- Cheerleaders will practice social distancing unless performing stunts. Masks will be worn anytime they are in the crowd but not when they are on the field.
- Concession will be operated with precautions. Items will be limited to pre-packaged and wrapped only items. Only bottled drinks will be sold. Workers will be limited due to space and must wear masks and gloves at all times while following social distance guidelines. No outside food and/or drinks permitted in the premises.
- Press box will be designated only for the event, coaching, and media staff. Each booth will be limited to 2 people.
- Coaches, players, officials, team personnel, and approved media personnel are only allowed on the field and track area. Cheerleaders are only allowed on the track areas behind their respective teams.
- Restrooms will be available and cleaned periodically.
- No one will be allowed on the field or track area after the game. All fans are expected to exit the stadium in an orderly way and not congregate while maintaining social distancing at all times.
